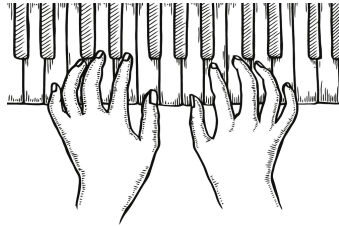
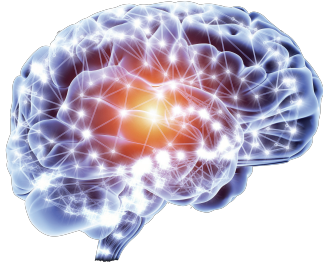


# Do you have Huntington's Disease and limitations with fine motor skills?
